



Moss Named Commission Chairman

The new chairman of the Rivanna River Basin Commission says he has big plans to fix up Central Virginia's waterways.

Fluvanna County Board of Supervisors Chairman Marvin Moss will also chair the commission. He's replacing Sally Thomas who is leaving at the end of the year. The commission is in its second year and Moss wants to focus on fixing the main problems of the Rivanna River.



"Well, mainly the principle problem that we've identified and focused on is storm water runoff. If you look at the Rivanna now, the river, overall, is in fairly good shape, but it has some tributaries," said Moss.

Now the commission plans to utilize a group they call "Stream Watch." That group comes out once a year to check up on the Rivanna's tributaries. Moss hopes by monitoring the river the water quality will improve.
