The Rivanna River Basin Commission will use \$725,000 in new grant money to help keep runoff pollutants out of the water. The group will target four different projects with the money.

Rain water sisterns, rain gardens and porous pavement will be installed at Charlottesville High School, Fluvanna County High School and the Greene County Community Park.

In Crozet the commission will construct wetlands in the planned town common to capture and treat runoff.
